



Dual Admissions Intent Form

Bucks County Community College and Chestnut Hill College enter into this Dual Admission Agreement so that students admitted into an Associate of Arts (A.A.), Associate of Science (A.S.) or Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) program at Bucks County Community College will be admitted into a Bachelor's degree program at CHC on the condition that they:

- Complete a Dual Admissions Intent Form, preferably before the completion of 30 credits, and the appropriate CHC application in the final year of the Bucks degree program.
- Graduate from Bucks with any Associate of Arts (A.A.), Associate of Science (A.S.), or Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree
- Graduate with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Students must complete a minimum of 45 academic credits at CHC in order to earn a degree.
- Submit transcripts from any additional school(s) attended and satisfy all other CHC admissions requirements.
