3. ACEN Criterion 5.4 – Job Placement Rate

2019-2020	80% new graduates will be employed in nursing positions	86.79%
2020-2021	80% new graduates will be employed in nursing positions	87.72%
2021-2022	80% new graduates will be employed in nursing positions	95.92%
