^{*}This major is available at Penn State Abington and online through Penn State World Campus. (Therefore, all of the courses are available online.) Although there are some restrictions, students enrolled at either campus are able to take courses at both Penn State campuses. Note also that this major, because it originates with the College of Nursing, is not part of the articulation agreement between Bucks CCC and Penn State Abington.

Note 1: BIOL 181 and 182, combined, fulfill Penn State's requirement in anatomy and physiology, BIO 129, 141, and 142 (8 credits, required).

Note 2: Students with a valid RN license receive 33 Nursing credits, required, through Portfolio Assessment by the College of Nursing.

Note 3: Any one of these courses will fulfill *both* the BCCC and the Penn State General Education requirements: VAFA 191, VAFA 192, VAFA 193, VAFA 194, VAFA 196, COMT 101, FCUL110, HIST 111, HIST 112, HIST 151, HIST 152, HUMN 111, HUMN 112, HUMN 113, HUMN 114, HUMN 120, LITR 205, LITR 206, LITR 231, LITR 232, LITR 254, LITR 255, LITR 261, LITR 271, LITR 275, LITR 278, MUSC 105, MUSC 106, *or* PHIL 125. (BCCC Foreign Language courses will count as Electives in this Penn State major.)

Note 4: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately. Penn State Abington's degree requires a minimum 2.0 GPA for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See psu.edu/admissions/.
