The BCCC student may also select MATH 101: Mathematical Concepts I (3) (MATH 122=) or MATH 115: Statistics (3)(MATH 130=) to fulfill the Math requirement at Bucks County Community College; however, neither of theses courses will fulfill the Core: Mathematics requirement at Holy Family University and another Math course which will fulfill the Core requirement will be required at Holy Family University

Literature Electives: 15 credits distributed in the following way:

English elective #1 – choose from among 200 level literature courses.

English elective #2 and #3 – choose from among 300 level literature courses (ENGL 302 is strongly recommended.)

English elective #4 and #5 – choose from among 400 level literature courses.

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Additional information regarding ENGLISH concentration:

@@ <u>ENGL 207: Intro to Literary Study</u>, is a gateway course in the concentration. Continuation in the program requires the course to be passed with a minimum of a "C" grade.

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for commencement honors. Additional free electives will be required to meet this requirement.

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester. Admitting in the Spring semester alters the program progression as outlined and will result in extending degree completion beyond the four semester sequence.
