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## MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to core requirements, at least one course from each Humanities discipline: Fine Arts, History, Literature (English or Foreign), Philosophy, Religious Studies.

Humanities Areas of Study: $\mathbf{4}$ courses required in a specific area of study.
American Studies: Courses from American Literature and American History
Studio Art/Art History: Any studio courses, plus ARTS 213 and ARTS 214.
Catholic Studies: Courses in religious studies that focus on Catholic teaching.
European Studies: Courses from European history, Art appreciation, Music Appreciation, and Opera.
Ethical Studies: Combination of courses in philosophy and religious studies.
Fine Arts: Combination of courses in Music, Theatre (Film, Acting, Visual Arts)
History: Combination of history offerings.
Philosophy: Any courses in Philosophy beyond core requirements.
Religious Studies: Any combination of Religious Studies offerings beyond core requirements.
Two seminars: - One in the area of study and one selected from another humanities area.
Additional information regarding HUMANITIES concentration.
Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for graduation honors. Additional free elective will be required to meet this requirement.

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester; however, admission is possible in both the Fall and Spring semesters in this program of study since course offerings permit sequence adjustment.
