1. Format options: Online Loud Cloud
2. Class Times/Schedule: No set time. Students must post 2X on 4 different days throughout the week.
3. Other class options (time/format) for accelerated students: Yes. Students may take more than 1 class at a time after their 3<sup>rd</sup> class so long as their GPA is above a 3.0.
4. Shortest timeframe to complete a bachelor's degree: 2 years
5. Maximum number of credits that may be taken in one semester/term/year: 90 credits/year
6. Full-time Online Tuition as follows: Online Education: \$440/credit Online Professional Studies: \$470/credit Online Theology: \$470/ Credit. Online Active Duty and Reserves: \$250/Credit Part-time tuition: No Is evening tuition different? **No**

### **Transfer Requirements**

1. Minimum admission requirements: None. Students may be admitted with specifications if their GPA is below a 3.0.

5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: 84
