Arcadia grants transfer credit in the amount awarded by the home institution, and recognizes equivalencies based on content, so students following the above program would be awarded 62 to 63 credits in transfer.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1. A grade of B or better is required in COMP110 to meet the English composition requirement at Arcadia. Grades below a B will require a placement exam and possible additional course(s) in English.
- 2. All transfer students to Arcadia University are required to complete the Global Connections Experience and Reflection. Students must also complete the Senior Capstone Project.
- 3. The maximum number of transfer credits that Arcadia University will accept from Bucks is 75. A minimum grade of "C-" is required to transfer a course to Arcadia.
- 4. Bucks and Arcadia University have a Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement. Students fulfilling Bucks' general education requirements for the A.A. or A.S. degrees automatically satisfy Arcadia's general education requirements with the exception of the Global Connection Experience and Reflection requirement, Senior Capstone project and up to 2 courses to be selected by the Arcadia University Registrar and department chair.
- 5. Bucks and Arcadia University also have a Guaranteed Transfer Agreement. Refer to the Bucks/Arcadia Agreement Fact Sheet & Guaranteed Transfer Intent Form available at Bucks to determine eligibility. Contact David Wood at Arcadia University or a Bucks Advisor for more information.
- 6. MATH 140, MATH 141, MATH 115, and MATH 215 are required for Arcadia University's B.S. degree in Accounting or Business Administration. However, MATH 115 and MATH 117 or 140 are required for the B.A. degree in Accounting or Business Administration. Arcadia recommends students take MATH 140.
- 7. Remaining requirements for the first two years of Arcadia's Program include BA101 International Business & Culture (MGMT 115 at BCCC). This requirement can be satisfied by completing BA344-International Marketing (pre-requisite is Principles of Marketing) or EC350-International Economics (pre-requisites are Macroeconomics and Microeconomics) at Arcadia University. Also required are EN218 Business Writing to be taken at Arcadia University and Statistics (MATH 115 at Bucks). Upper-level BA and EC requirements are offered in 15-week face-to-face, 7-week partially online, and 7-week fully online formats.
- 8. At least 50% of the requirements for the major must be completed at Arcadia University.
