Math and Science

Delaware Valley University and Bucks County Community College

<u>DVU Basic Math Requirement</u> – all students at DVU need at least 6 credits of Math that include the equivalent of <u>MP 1203 Elementary Functions</u> (Bucks's MATH 125 Precalculus), except in degree programs where the mathematics requirement is higher. The Math requirement does not have to be started or completed at the time of transfer. Students transferring to DVC without transfer credit for DVU's MP1102 College Algebra will have to take the DVU Math placement test.

MATH120 & 125 at Bucks will satisfy DVU's basic requirement <u>or</u> the basic requirement can be satisfied with <u>MATH140 Calculus I</u>; this will allow the student two additional free elective credits at DVU.

For NON-Science Majors only, MATH117 & 118 can satisfy DVU's Math requirement also.

Alone, MATH117 or MATH120 will transfer as DVC's MP 1102 College Algebra.

<u>Alone, MATH125</u> will transfer as <u>MP1203</u> <u>Elementary Functions</u> and the student will have to take an upper level Math course here at DVU.
