

**Bucks County Community College & Drexel University Intent to Enroll**  
**Dual Admission**

Completion of this *Dual Admission Intent to Enroll Form* entitles you to be admitted, upon graduation from a designated Bucks County Community College (“Bucks”) Associate’s degree program, into a Bachelor’s degree program at Drexel University (“Drexel”) provided that you:

1. Complete this form in accordance with all stipulated Drexel admission requirements. This form must be completed any time prior to earning 45 college-level credits.
2. Review and return the *Dual Admissions Acknowledgement Letter*, signed, to Drexel at [transferadmissions@drexel.edu](mailto:transferadmissions@drexel.edu).
3. Graduate from Bucks with an Associate degree with the required grade point average listed on the below grid for the corresponding college/major at Drexel.
4. Confirm your intention to matriculate at Drexel by submitting Drexel’s online application at [admissions.drexel.edu/apply](http://admissions.drexel.edu/apply) and selecting the Transfer, Full Time application. This should be submitted by June 1 for the fall term, October 15 for the winter term, and February 1 for the spring term. Please note that not all majors enroll in every term.
5. Read the Dual Admission Agreement in its entirety and provide the required information below.
