#### Additional Information regarding CRIMINAL JUSTICE major:

Internship is a requirement within the major. A total of four (4) credits of internship are required.

Students must contact Faculty internship instructor prior to registration for internship.

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

### Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for commencement honors.
