Bucks-La Salle Dual Admission Students: Please refer to the Dual Admission application for eligibility requirements. Students interested in applying to La Salle through the Dual Admission program must sign the Dual Admission Application before completing 45 college-level credits. The Dual Admission Agreement includes a Core-to-Core component. Under the Dual Admission agreement, La Salle University’s Core will essentially be fulfilled by the Core at Bucks County Community College. In order to meet the requirements of La Salle’s Core, students must take **CORE Qualifiers** – one Philosophy course, one Religion course and one Computer Science course – at La Salle if they have not taken courses at Bucks that will fulfill these requirements. See recommendations on the reverse side under “Advising Notes Related to Core Qualifiers” for which specific Bucks courses will fulfill these requirements.

Non-Dual Admission students who transfer to La Salle University will be required to meet the complete La Salle Core, which includes two Religion courses, two Philosophy courses and one Computer Science course, among others. The courses recommended on this Transfer Guide will better prepare students for transfer to La Salle University.

La Salle will accept credit on a case by case basis earned through one of the following sources: the College Level Examination Program (CLEP), the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support Program (DANTES) and in accordance with the recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE).

IMPORTANT NOTES ON OTHER SIDE

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Advising Notes Related to Core Qualifiers – For Dual Admission Students:

- 1) If students choose to take PHIL125 it will satisfy the **Cultural Perspectives** requirement for this major, and also meets the Philosophy Core Qualifier at La Salle. Any Philosophy (PHIL) course at Bucks satisfies La Salle's Philosophy Core Qualifier.
- 2) If students choose to take HUMN120 it will satisfy the **Cultural Perspectives** requirement for this major, and also meets the Religion Core Qualifier at La Salle. Other Religion courses at Bucks that satisfy La Salle's Religion Core Qualifier are HUMN121, HUMN122, HUMN125, HUMN127, HUMN128, and HUMN129.
- 3) Students should take CISC100 Introduction to Computers or CISC110 Introduction to Information Systems as an elective at Bucks to satisfy La Salle's Computer Science Core Qualifier.

Advising Notes Related to Major Course Requirements:

- 1) For the **College Level Mathematics or Science**, please refer to the list of acceptable courses on the Bucks website.
- 2) For **Foreign Language or Humanities**, take any foreign language or HUMN111, HUMN112, HUMN113, HUMN114 or HUMN120. Dual Admission students, see the note above regarding Philosophy and Religion Core Qualifiers.
- 3) For the general **Electives**, please note that pre-college level courses do not meet this requirement. Transferable Elective credits will depend on your intended major at La Salle. Please seek advisement on course selection.
- 4) For **Personal Health**, choose from the following for elective credit: HLTH120 Nutrition, COMM105 Interpersonal Communication, PSYC120 Human Sexuality or PSYC125 Stress Management. Other courses listed on the Bucks website that meet this A.A. requirement are not transferable to La Salle.
- 5) For the **Arts** elective, it is recommended to choose from the VAFA and MUSC courses listed on the Bucks website.
- 6) For the **Cultural Perspectives** requirement, it is permitted to take FCUL110, HIST111, HIST112, HIST151, HIST152 or any Foreign Language course. Non-Dual Admission students will meet a La Salle Core requirement by taking HIST111 or HIST112 (*see note 8 below*). FCUL110 will transfer as a Communication major elective for Communication students at La Salle.
- 7) For the **Social Perspectives** requirement, it is recommended that Non-Dual Admission students choose from: ECON111 or POLI111 to fulfill part of La Salle's School of Arts and Sciences Core requirements.
- 8) For the Bucks **History** requirement, it is recommended that Non-Dual Admission students take one of the following: HIST100 American Studies Seminar (to satisfy HIS 155 Themes in American History at La Salle) or HIST111 History of Western Civilization I (to satisfy HIS 151 Global History to 1500) or HIST112 History of Western Civilization II (to satisfy HIS 251 Global History from 1500 to Present). La Salle's Core includes HIS 251 and the choice of either HIS 155 or HIS 151.
- 9) For the **Social and Behavioral Sciences** requirement, it is recommended that Non-Dual Admission students choose from: PSYC110 or SOCI110 to fulfill part of La Salle's School of Arts and Sciences Core requirements.

Additional Notes:

- 1) The maximum number of credits that a student may transfer to La Salle is 70. Additional courses beyond the Associate degree can be taken at Bucks to meet program requirements at La Salle.
- 2) Students are strongly advised to use this guide with the assistance of Transfer Services at Bucks. The information in this transfer guide is subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to check periodically with Transfer Services for up-to-date information and to contact the Assistant Dean at La Salle, listed below, for advisement on major requirements that can be taken at Bucks. Following this guide does not guarantee the transfer of credit or admission to La Salle University. **A transfer student must complete at least half the major courses at La Salle.**
