- 5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: No maximum. We require 30 of the last 60 credits and at least 50% of the major credits to be earned at Clarion, however.
- 6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Immediately after acceptance or they can inquire as a prospect before they apply and receive a credit review within 72 hours of submitting unofficial transcript.**
- 7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **No**
- 8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **Yes.** Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? **Yes.** With less than 30 credits? **Yes.**
