1. Is on-campus housing available for transfer students? **Yes** Cost? \$16,832/year

2. Full-time tuition: **Approx. \$33,778/year** Part-time tuition: **\$1,075 per credit** Is evening tuition different? **No** 

- 3. Scholarship availability for transfer students: Yes, every student is automatically considered for merit-based scholarship
  - -Transfer Presidential Scholarship = 11,000/year (GPA: 3.5 or above)
  - -Transfer Dean's Scholarship = \$9,000/year (GPA: 3.0-3.49)
  - -Transfer Recognition Award = \$7,000/year (GPA: 2.5-2.99)
  - -Community College Honor Society Scholarship = \$1,000/year if proof of PTK, Alpha Beta Gamma, or other recognized honor society is submitted
- 4. Can a transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in two years? Yes, but it depends on their major. Performing Arts majors can often take a longer time.
- 5. Can a transfer student complete baccalaureate programs on an evening schedule? We have evening classes, but not everything is offered at night so you usually can't complete a degree solely at night.

**Transfer Requirements** 

- 1. Best time(s) to apply? Fall Semester: Between September-March. Spring Semester: Between July-November Deadline(s): Rolling admission: we accept applications until the beginning the Fall &Spring semesters. We render decisions 2-3 weeks after receiving all application materials. We also offer Instant Decision!
- 2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.3 and above**

Prefer? 2.5 and above

- 3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: N/A
- 4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **If student attended one school, we accept. If student attended multiple schools, we recalculate**
- 5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: 90 credits
- 6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Approx 2-3 weeks after they have been accepted, we will send out a Preliminary Credit Evaluation**
- 7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **If earned fewer than 12 college credits when they are applying.**
- 8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? If student is applying with less than 12 college credits completed, we require an official high school transcript or GED. If more than 12 college credits are completed, we only require a copy of High School or GED diploma.

Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? **Yes – See Above.** 

With less than 30 credits? Yes – See Above.

- 9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **No course requirements.**
- 10. Are D's transferable? No. With an AA degree? No. Without an AA degree? No. Explain. We do not accept Ds in transfer.
- 11. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? We would have to have original documentation of the scores and complete our own review of PLA credit.
