Scholarship availability for transfer students: Only one transfer merit-based scholarship is available, the criteria and amount of the scholarship differs year to year based on our budget and the pool of applicants we receive. In past years we were able to give out over 100 one-time scholarships ranging in amounts from \$500-\$2,000.
- 4. Can a transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in two years? Yes
- 5. Can a transfer student complete baccalaureate programs on an evening schedule? **No** If so, in what programs?

## Transfer Requirements

- 1. Best time(s) to apply? End of January for Fall enrollment; end of September for spring enrollment Deadline(s): Rolling admissions, we do not have a deadline for our applications to be submitted by. Although, we encourage students to apply sooner rather than later.
- 2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.0** Prefer?
- 3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: We do not have GPA requirements for any of our programs, but we do have special course requirements for students who wish to be admitted directly into the Sociology program. Students must take the equivalent of SOCY 101, receive a C or better and take the equivalent of MATH 130, receive a C- or better.
- 4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? Accept as calculated by previous college
- 5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: at least 30 credits including 50% of major/minor requirements MUST be completed at MU for MU to award degree. Ideally students from a community college will have a maximum of 65 credits. More than 65 credits would be accepted as long as above requirement is met.
- 6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Preliminary credit evaluation is included with admission letter.**
- 7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? Only if fewer than 12 transferable credits have been completed at time of application.
- 8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **No** Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? **No** With less than 30 credits? **Only required with less than 12 transferable credits.**
- 9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **No**If yes, can these be satisfied by college courses?
  Will these courses also be credited toward the baccalaureate?
- 10. Are D's transferable? Yes, with the exception of English Composition & Public Speaking which require a minimum C-.
  With an AA degree? Yes Without an AA degree? Yes (see above) Explain.
- 11. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? Yes, credit can be awarded for experiences, but official scores are required. We do not accept them off the Bucks transcript.
