- 4 Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **Depends on major, but university policy is to accept up to 90 credits** whenever possible, from any 2 or 4 year college.
- 5. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? At the time of acceptance the student is provided with log-in information to view transfer credits in their account.
- 6. Must SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? Not if over 24 credits completed
