General Information

1. Best time(s) to apply? **At least one semester before intended transfer.** Deadline(s): **Rolling**
2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.0** Prefer? **2.2 or better**
3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **15 Majors with GPA and or Pre-requisite course requirements. Please refer to website: http://www.ship.edu/admissions/transfers/major_requirements/**
4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **Re-calculate without developmental classes from previous institutions, regardless of grade.**
5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **Unlimited, but a student must earn 30 of the last 45 credits at Ship.**
6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Shortly after they receive their offer of admission.**
7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **Same as # 8.**
8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **High school transcripts or GED only required for students who have completed less than 12 transferrable credits. Students pursuing a BA degree may want to consider submitting this information in order waive Foreign Language Requirement (3 years of 1 language in high school will waive requirement).**
9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **No,** If yes, can these be satisfied by college courses? **See #8** Will these courses also be credited toward the baccalaureate?
10. Are D's transferable? **Yes** With an AA degree? **Yes** Without an AA degree? **Yes** Explain. **PASSPORT schools only.**
11. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? **We accept AP, IB and CLEP. Other PLA is not accepted. Official reports required.**
