General Information

- 1. Available baccalaureate programs: Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (39 credits), Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership (45 credits), Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN-42 credits), Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (66 credits), Bachelor of Arts in Youth Ministry (45 credits), Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice (51 credits)
- 2. Format options: All are accelerated majors designed in the cohort model with 7 week classes.
- 3. Class Times/Schedule: BS in Business Administration, BA in Organizational Leadership = Students can do these programs in a classroom or 100% online. In a classroom setting, they meet one night a week from 6pm to 10pm with an additional 3 hours online time for 7 weeks. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN), BA in Youth Ministry = Students can complete these programs 100% online (w/ Youth Minstry there is a weekend residency). BS in Early Childhood Education, BA in Criminal Justice = only meet in a classroom setting one night a week from 6pm to 10pm with an additional 3 hours of online time.
- 4. Other class options (time/format) for accelerated students: See #3
- 5. Shortest timeframe to complete a bachelor's degree: **Depends, but can be done in one and a half to 2 years if students comes in** with an optimal amount of credits. After the major is complete, students are required to fulfill CORE classes if they haven't completed them yet, which is typically another few months for students to complete the CORE classes, before they earn their bachelors. A minimum of 121 semester credits and successful completion of major and core curriculum are required to obtain a Bachelor's degree. Final 32 credits must be earned from Eastern University.
- 6. Maximum number of credits that may be taken in one semester/term/year: Since we operate in an accelerated format, students can take up to 2 classes per 7 week period.
- 7. Full-time tuition: All programs are \$569/credit.
 - This tuition is for the 2018-2019 academic year
- 8. Part-time tuition: All of the above programs are considered full-time even though they meet one night a week.
- Scholarship availability for transfer students: Students who graduate from Bucks County Community College, receive a 20% discount off of tuition.
- 10. Support services/organizations available for students in nontraditional programs: Within Eastern University's Campolo College of Graduate & Professional Studies, there are Career Services and Student Services teams. All students at Eastern have equal access to the amenities at the university, but these two teams are specific to the needs of working adults.

Transfer Requirements

- 1. Minimum admission requirements: Application, DOLE Form, All Official HS and/or College Transcripts (RN-BSN must have valid RN License & Early Childhood Education must have a resume)
- 2. Deadline(s) to apply: Students can enroll at any 7 week start (January, March, May, June/July, August, or October)
- 3. Minimum grade point average (4.0 scale) required: **2.0** Preferred: **2.5** For specific programs: **Must have a 2.5 GPA for Early Childhood Education**
- 4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **We accept as calculated by Bucks County Community College.**
- 5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: 89 credits
- 6. Associate degree required? **No** Preferred? **Yes**
- 7. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? Once they apply and send in their official college transcripts—this way an official credit evaluation can be complete. An unofficial credit evaluation can be completed by a recruiter in the meantime of obtaining the official transcripts.
- 8. Must SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer student? No
- 9. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? No Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? Depends, high school transcripts will be waived if student has 30 or more credits from the same college/university. If student has 30 or more credits divided over more than one college/university, then the transcript is required. With less than 30 credits? Yes, high school transcripts would be required for admission.
- 10. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? **Yes. We would require that the official copies be sent to us of the test or assessment.**
