Note 1: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's General Education requirements:

- o 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- o 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences (fulfilled by the major requirements)
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 6 credits in Quantification (3 credits fulfilled by the major requirement)
- o 9 credits in Natural Sciences (3 credits are fulfilled by the major requirements)

Note 2: This major requires 21 credits of Electives. Students in this Major should consider a Penn State Minor in Psychology or Sociology (18 credits, including 6 at the 400-level). Other Minors are available.

Note 3: Take any 4-credit BIOL, CHEM, or SCIE.

Note 4: Penn State suggests taking any one of the following courses: VAFA 191, VAFA 192, VAFA 193, VAFA 194, VAFA 196, COMT 101, FCUL 110, HIST 111, HIST 112, HIST 151, HIST 152, HUMN 111, HUMN 112, HUMN 113, HUMN 114, HUMN 120, LITR 205, LITR 206, LITR 231, LITR 232, LITR 254, LITR 255, LITR 261, LITR 271, LITR 273, LITR 275, LITR 277, LITR 278, LITR 279, MUSC 101, MUSC 105, MUSC 106, or PHIL 125. See Note 1. **Note also** that these courses from the list above fulfill Penn State's General Education *and* International Cultures requirements: VAFA 191, VAFA 192, VAFA 193, COMT 101, FCUL 110, HIST 111, HIST 112, or HUMN 120.

Note 5: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately. Penn State Abington's Rehab and Human Services major requires a minimum 2.0 GPA for transfer as calculated by Penn State. This Transfer Guide may change without notice before the student is admitted to Penn State Abington.

Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See **psu.edu/admissions/.**
