*This major is offered at Penn State Abington with two "Options": Design and Development or Integration and Application option.

Note 1: Due to the sequence of courses required for Penn State's IST major, Bucks students who complete the A.A. in Computer Science should expect to spend at least 5 semesters (or the equivalent) to complete the Penn State major. Some exceptions are made for well-qualified students. Bucks

students preferring to transfer before completing the A.A. degree should follow the "Advising Guide (May 2016) for Computer Science or IST."

Note 2: This major requires 12 credits in Support of Option, technical courses that the student has chosen and approved by Penn State. It also requires 6 credits of Electives.

Note 3: Take either PHYS 121 and 122 or CHEM 121 and 122.

Note 4: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for the major:

- o 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 3 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences. 3 additional credits are fulfilled by a required Economics course in the major.
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- o 9 credits in Natural Sciences
- The General Education requirement for 6 credits of Quantification are fulfilled by the Major Requirements
- 3 credits in United States Cultures and 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Heritage History = both Humanities and International Cultures)

Note 5: Although BCCC requires COMP 111, Penn State Abington requires COMP 114, Technical Writing, for this major. A student should obtain permission to substitute from Bucks CCC Department. Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL202B. COMP 111 may not transfer. It is presently equivalent to COMP110, and it is being reviewed.

Note 6: Penn State suggests a course, CISC 128. Note that these courses will *not* transfer: CISC 110, 201, 202, 244, and 280.

Note 7: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately. Penn State Abington's degree requires a minimum 2.0 GPA for transfer.

Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See **psu.edu/admissions/.**
