Note 1: The Art and the Integrative Arts majors allow for 18 credits of Electives.

Note 2: VAFA 101 and any VAFA XXX (6 credits), *combined*, are equivalent to ART 110 (3 credits). The additional 3 credits transfer as Electives.

Note 3: VAFA 102 and VAFA 105 (6 credits), *combined*, are equivalent to ART 111 (3 credits). The additional 3 credits transfer as Electives.

Note 4: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL202B. Students who take it after that date will receive no credit because the course transfers as COMP 110. COMP 111 is under review.

Note 5: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for the Art and the Integrative Arts major:

- 6 credits in Arts (fulfilled by the major requirements)
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences
- o 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 6 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics). Take MATH 101,
 102, 110, 115, or higher.
- 9 credits in Natural Sciences
- 3 credits in United States Cultures and 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Heritage History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirement)

Note 6: BCCC requires one of three courses: VAMM 100 transfers as Art; VACV 140 transfers as Communication; VAPH110 has not been evaluated.

Note 7: Take any VAFA, but VAFA 147, 148, and 250 will not transfer. Take any VAGD, but VAGD 101 will not transfer. Take any VAFW, but VAFW 100 will not transfer. Take any VAMM. VAPH courses have not yet been evaluated by Penn State.

Note 8: The Art and Integrative Arts majors allow for 9 credits of Bachelor of Arts Requirements.

Note 9: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill the General Education, Health and Physical Activity requirement: PSYC 125 or HLTH 103, 110, 120, or 130. Note that Penn State requires 3 credits of Health and Physical Activity.

Note 10: From the BCCC list, take ECON 111, GEOG 110, POLI 111, PSYC 110 or SOCI 110 to fulfill Penn State General Education requirement for Social and Behavioral Sciences. See Note 5.

Note 11: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately.

Penn State Abington's Art and Integrative Arts degrees require a **minimum 2.0 GPA**. Art majors also require a successful portfolio evaluation. Students applying for admission to the Integrative Arts major complete a Proposal.

Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See psu.edu/admissions/.

This Transfer Guide is designed for **Penn State Abington ONLY**. Students seeking transfer admission to U. Park, Behrend, Harrisburg, or other Penn State campuses should contact that campus directly.
