Note 1: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for this major:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- o 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 3 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics); 3 additional credits are fulfilled by a course required for the Major
- o 6 credits in Natural Science; 3 additional credits are fulfilled by a course required for the Major
- 3 credits in United State Cultures and 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Civilization History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirements)

Note 2: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill General Education, Arts, requirement: COMT 101 or 103; MUSC 101, 105, or 106; VACV 142; VAFA 100, 107, 111, 141, 160, 161, 171, 181, 191, 192, 193, or 194.

Note 3: SOCI 110 is a prerequisite for sociology courses required for the Penn State PsychSoc major.

Note 4: BCCC says take BIOL 102, CHEM 101, PHYS 106, BIOL 220, SCIE 103, or SCIE 105.

Note 5: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL 202B. COMP 111 is under review. Current Bucks CCC students should request permission to *substitute* COMP 114 for COMP 111 to receive credit for ENGL 202C, Technical Writing.

Note 6: Take any one 3-4 credit course in BIOL, CHEM, PHYS, or SCIE.

Note 7: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill the General Education, Health and Physical Activity requirement: PSYC 125 or HLTH 103, 110, 120, or 130. Note that Penn State requires 3 credits of Health and Physical Activity.

Note 8: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately. Penn State Abington's degree requires a minimum 2.0 GPA for transfer as calculated by Penn State. This Transfer Guide may change without notice before the student is admitted to Penn State Abington.

Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See **psu.edu/admissions/.**

This Transfer Guide is designed for **Penn State Abington ONLY**. Students seeking transfer admission to U. Park, Behrend, Harrisburg, or other Penn State campuses should contact that campus directly.
