Note 1: This major requires 6 credits of Electives for B.S., and 18 credits of Electives and 18 credits of B.A. Requirements for B.A.

Note2: BCCC says take HIST 111, 112, 151, or 152. Penn State suggests HIST 151 or 152 to fulfill two requirements: General Education, Humanities, *and* United States Cultures. See Note 2.

Note 3: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for this major:

- o 6 credits in Arts
- o 6 credits in Humanities
- o 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- o 3 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics)
- o 6 credits in Natural Science; 3 additional credits are fulfilled by a course required for the Major
- 3 credits in United State Cultures and 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Civilization History = both Humanities and International Cultures

Note 4: Penn State suggests one of the following LITR courses to fulfill the General Education, Humanities, International Cultures requirement: LITR 205, 206, 234, 254, 255, or 278.

Note 5: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL 202B. After that date, students will receive no transfer credits because the course transfers as COMP 110. COMP 111 is under review. Current Bucks CCC students should request permission to *substitute* COMP 114 for COMP 111 to receive credit for ENGL 202C, Technical Writing.

Note 6: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill General Education, Arts, requirement: COMT 101 or 103; MUSC 101, 105, or 106; VACV 142; VAFA 100, 107, 111, 141, 160, 161, 171, 181, 191, 192, 193, or 194. See Note 3.

Note 7: Take any 3- or 4-credit BIOL, CHEM, or SCIE.

Note 8: Additional Policies: Transferable courses MUST have a grade of "C" or better. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university must be evaluated separately. Penn State Abington's degree requires a minimum 2.0 GPA for transfer as calculated by Penn State.

Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See **psu.edu/admissions/.**

This Transfer Guide is designed for **Penn State Abington ONLY**. Students seeking transfer admission to U. Park, Behrend, Harrisburg, or other Penn State campuses should contact that campus directly.
