*BCCC students could also enter the Penn State major and follow the Transfer Guide for Social Work; Psychology, Interpersonal Emphasis; or Psychology Pre-Professional Emphasis.

Note 1: This major requires 21 credits of Electives. Students should consider a Penn State Minor (usually 18 credits, including 6 credits at the 400 level). Sociology, Psychology, and other Minors are available. See the Penn State transfer counselor for details.

Note 2: BCCC says take HIST 111, 112, 151, or 152. Penn State suggests HIST 151 or 152 to fulfill two requirements: General Education, Humanities, *and* United States Cultures. See Note 3.

Note 3: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for this major:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences (all are fulfilled by the Major courses)
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 3 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics); 3 credits are fulfilled by a course required for the Major
- 6 credits in Natural Science; 3 credits are fulfilled by a course required for the Major
- 3 credits in United State Cultures *and* 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Civilization History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirements)

Note 4: Penn State suggests one of the following LITR courses to fulfill the International Cultures requirement: LITR 205, 206, 234, 254, 255, or 278.

Note 5: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL202B. After that date, students will receive no transfer credit because the course transfers as COMP 110. COMP 111 is under review. Current Bucks CCC students should request permission to *substitute* COMP 114 for COMP 111 to receive credit for ENGL202C, Technical Writing.

Note 6: Students who take Math 115 and Math 215, *combined*, will receive credit for STAT200, a required course in this major. The additional credits transfer as Electives. Students who take both courses will fulfill the GE, Quantification requirement (6 credits). MATH 115 when taken alone is STAT100 and it will fulfill 3 credits of GE, Quantification.

Note 7: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill the General Educations, Health and Physical Activity requirement: HLTH 103, 110, 120, or 130. Note that Penn State requires 3 credits of Health and Physical Activity.

Note 8: Penn State suggests two of the following to fulfill General Education, Arts, requirement: COMT 101 or 103; MUSC 101, 105, or 106; VACV 142; VAFA 100, 107, 111, 141, 160, 161, 171, 181, 191, 192, 193, or 194.

Note 9: **Additional Policies:** Transferable courses **MUST** have a grade of **"C" or better**. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university **must be evaluated separately**. Penn State Abington's degree requires a **minimum 2.0 GPA** for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See psu.edu/admissions/.

This Transfer Guide is designed for **Penn State Abington ONLY**. Students seeking transfer admission to U. Park, Behrend, Harrisburg, or other Penn State campuses should contact that campus directly.
