As of Fall 2013 course re-evaluation at Holy Family University.

MATH 120: College Algebra (4) (Core: Quantification)

MATH 122: Trigonometry/Analytic Geometry (3) (MATH 150=)

MATH 125: Pre-calculus Mathematics (4) (MATH 150=)

MATH 140: Calculus I (4) (MATH 211=)

*The BCCC student may also select MATH 101: Mathematical Concepts I (3) (MATH 122=) or MATH 115: Statistics (3)(MATH 130=) to fulfill the Math requirement at Bucks County Community College; however, **neither** of these courses will fulfill the Core: Mathematics requirement at Holy Family University and another Math course which will fulfill the Core requirement will be required at Holy Family University*

(**) Select from the following science courses: At least ONE science Course selection MUST have a laboratory component.

Lab courses: BIOL 101 (GSCI 104); CHEM 101

Non-lab courses: SCIE 101; SCIE 102; SCIE 103 (GSCI 108); BIOL 110

The course selected will fulfill the Humanities: History course requirement within the major.

(#) Any ECON; GEOG; POLI; PSYC (except PSYC 100): SOCI may be chosen. (consult with advisor at BCCC when making selection) Course selected will fulfill a required free elective at Holy Family.

@ Any Philosophy course may be selected to fulfill the Philosophy course requirement within the major

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MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to core requirements, at least one course from each Humanities discipline: Fine Arts, History, Literature (English or Foreign), Philosophy, Religious Studies.

Humanities Areas of Study: 4 courses required in a specific area of study.

American Studies : Courses from American Literature and American History

Studio Art/Art History: Any studio courses, plus ARTS 213 and ARTS 214.

Catholic Studies: Courses in religious studies that focus on Catholic teaching.

European Studies: Courses from European history, Art appreciation, Music Appreciation, and Opera.

Ethical Studies: Combination of courses in philosophy and religious studies.

Fine Arts: Combination of courses in Music, Theatre (Film, Acting, Visual Arts)

History: Combination of history offerings.

Philosophy: Any courses in Philosophy beyond core requirements.

Religious Studies: Any combination of Religious Studies offerings beyond core requirements.

Two seminars: - One in the area of study and one selected from another humanities area.

Additional information regarding HUMANITIES concentration.

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for graduation honors.
Additional free elective will be required to meet this requirement.

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester; however, admission is possible in both the Fall and Spring semesters in this program of study since course offerings permit sequence adjustment.
