The student may select one course from the following courses to fulfill the Lab science requirement at Bucks as well as the CORE: Natural Science with a lab requirement at Holy Family University:

BIOL 101 (GSCI 104); BIOL 102 (NS with lab); CHEM 101 (NS with lab); PHYS 106 (GSCI 110).

Note: Holy Family University requires two natural science courses – one with a lab and one without a lab; therefore, another science will need to be completed at Holy Family University.

Additional information regarding Accounting concentration:

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination, which is incorporated into the BUSAD 435 course, is required.

Completion of CBE exam in the Senior Seminar course.

Note: A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for commencement honors.

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester. Admitting in the Spring semester alters the program progression as outlined and will result in extending degree completion beyond the four semester sequence.
