- Tuition ranges from \$90-\$290

For those preparing for Credit AESL and are seeking a college degree and for students on F-1 visas.

- Beginning to Intermediate
- 2 levels
- 3 – 21 hours per week, Monday – Thursday
- Courses offered in Writing, Reading, Listening/Speaking, Culture, and Computer Skills provide comprehensive preparation for academic work in an American college or university.
- Taken together, these courses fulfill the requirements for F-1 full-time study.
- Costs range from \$175 - \$465 per course; the full program is \$1200, includes all text books.
- Classes begin every eight weeks, starting in September 2008.
