If you have lived in PA for two or more years, then you may apply for a criminal

background check through the State Police. If you have not lived in PA for two years, then

you need to apply for an FBI check. There are two ways to apply for a criminal

background check for the State Police. The fee is \$10.

1. On line https://epatch.state.pa.us, which only takes 1-2 days (sometimes you can

print your results immediately) to get the results back.

2. Complete the Criminal Background form and send directly to State Police,

which may take from 4-6 weeks for the results.


