Personal information


- Social Security numbers for you and your parents
- Drivers license number
- Alien registration number or permanent residence card
- You need to have a FSA ID to sign your form electronically. You can apply at www.fsa.gov to receive this FSA ID, remember both the parent and student must have a FSA ID to complete the process.
- Parents are encouraged to attend

Income information

- W-2's, or other record of money earned
- Social Security, TANF benefits, welfare benefits, veterans benefits records
- Student & parent Federal Tax Returns: 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ

Asset information

- Recent bank statements, recent business & investment mortgage information, business & farm records, stock, bond, & other investment records if applicable
