

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION TO THE CLINICAL COMPONENT IN NURSING

FALL – 2011 to start in Fall 2012

Completely fill out the **yellow** application (If submitting a copy printed from the internet it must be on **yellow** paper.) The following must be attached:

- Copy of SAT or ACT scores posted on WebAdvisor from “Test Summary Page.” If your scores are not posted on WebAdvisor you must request official scores be sent to Admissions from www.collegeboard.com or www.act.com (scores will not be retrieved from a high school transcript.)
- Copy of your most recent Evaluation of Program of Study from WebAdvisor. You must be enrolled to be accepted.
- If your major is not currently 2035, the letter you received from Admissions advising that your major will be changed.

Applications will be accepted by appointment only, beginning October 17, 2011. The deadline for accepting applications is December 15, 2011.

- You must make an appointment to review and sign your application.
 - NOTE: The application will not be considered unless signed by the appointed AD Nursing Advisor, Nursing Faculty, the Director, or the Assistant Academic Dean.
- During the College-wide open advising period, appointment times will be posted on Nursing Faculty doors for sign-up. For your convenience, Faculty names, office, and telephone numbers are attached. The Faculty member will sign your application and submit the application to the Director, Associate Degree Nursing at the completion of the appointment.
- All applications will be reviewed after the deadline date and final grades have been posted.

Acceptance status is not based on how soon you submit your application. Applications are reviewed for and ranked by:

1. Currently enrolled in the College
2. Meets high school requirements
3. Curriculum Code of 2035 (Nursing)
4. Have a grade of C or better in ALL courses required in the Nursing Program of Study, taken before applying for admission into the Clinical Component of Nursing. All required courses, with a grade of less than C, taken prior to entry into the Clinical Component of the Nursing Program **MUST** be repeated before acceptance into the Clinical Component.
5. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 at BCCC. If additional seats are available, a sliding scale will be used to accept students with a GPA of minimally 2.0.
6. SAT of 900 or above on Critical Reading and Math, OR ACT of 20 or above OR, NLN-RN Pre Nursing Exam of 50th percentile or above with 55th percentile preferred. **NLN Examination must be completed by the Nov. 19th testing deadline. All applicants must have official SAT/ACT scores (in order to be deemed official, document must be sent directly from issuing institution, The College Board, to Admissions and received by the college by December 15th.**
7. **Students who are Bucks County residents and have completed the highest number of credits in the Nursing Program of Study from BCCC with a final grade of C or better will be considered first, after meeting all of the above criteria.** There has not been space for an out of county resident in the past 5 years.
