Following is sample bequest language that may assist you and your estate planning professional. Specific Bequest

I give, devise, and bequeath \$X or X asset(s) to the Bucks County Community College Foundation (EIN 22-245-6105) located at 275 Swamp Road – Newtown, PA 18940, for its general use and purposes.

Percentage Bequest

I give, devise, and bequeath X% of my estate to the Bucks County Community College Foundation (EIN 22-245-6105) located at 275 Swamp Road – Newtown, PA 18940, for its general use and purposes.

Residuary Bequest

I give, devise, and bequeath the rest, residue and remainder of my estate consisting of property, both real and personal, wherever situated, which I may own or be entitled to at my death, to the Bucks County Community College Foundation (EIN 22-245-6105) located at 275 Swamp Road – Newtown, PA 18940, for its general use and purposes.

Even though the above examples specify an unrestricted gift to the College, you can designate your bequest of \$5,000 or more for specific purposes such as an academic scholarship, a departmental project, or faculty support. It is important to specifically outline your gift, so that your intentions can be fulfilled. In addition, please inform us of your bequest so that we can properly acknowledge your generous support, or inform you in case we are unable to accommodate your wishes at this time.
