

Det. Sgt. George F. Stuckey Memorial Scholarship

Application

Established by the Bristol Township Police Benevolent Association to honor one of their own; Bristol Township Police Det. Sgt. George F. Stuckey, who was shot and killed in the line of duty on March 29, 1972. Det. Sgt. Stuckey was fatally wounded during a shootout with suspects who had just robbed a nearby bank. This dedicated officer made the ultimate sacrifice on Bath Road, Bristol, Pa., within sight of the Bristol Township Police Headquarters. Det. Sgt. Stuckey left behind a wife and two children. He is missed, but never to be forgotten.

This scholarship is open to a second-year student who, at the time of application, completed a minimum of 30 credits at BCCC, possesses a 2.5 cumulative GPA or better, and is enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credits in the Department of Social & Behavioral Science's Criminal Justice program with an emphasis in police administration.

Preference is given to applicants who reside in Bristol Township.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

\$500 will be credited to the recipient's student account in the fall semester. Upon the recipient's student return to BCCC for the spring or summer semester, the second \$500 installment will be credited.
