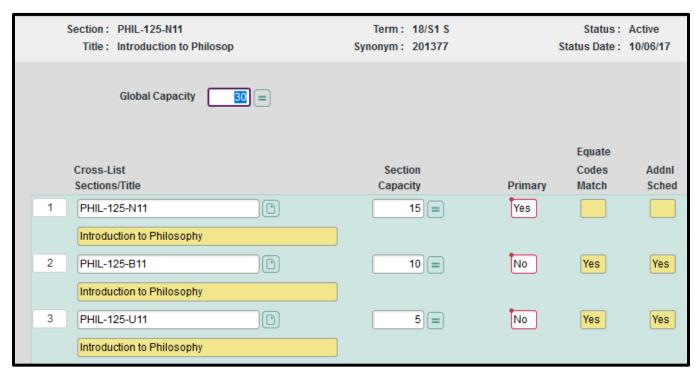
Cross-Listing Sections in Colleague

Example: 18/S1 PHIL-125-N11 (primary), PHIL-125-B11, PHIL-125-U11

1. Open the **SECT** screen in Colleague and enter the primary section. In this example, PHIL-125-N11. Click the additional details icon next to **Cross-Listings**.

2. The primary section will appear first. On lines 2 and 3 enter the additional sections. The Section Capacity will appear next to each new section.



3. Fill in the **Global Capacity** at the top of the screen. Global capacity is the maximum number of students who may be enrolled in the combined sections of the cross-list. If this field is left blank, Colleague assumes that there is no limit as to how many students may register for this cross-list, so it is imperative that Global Capacity is entered.



4. After you have completed all changes, click **Save All**.



Note: All sections of the cross-listed course will be updated. If you check SECT > Cross-Listings for PHIL-125-B11 or PHIL-125-U11, the cross-listing screen will appear exactly the same.
