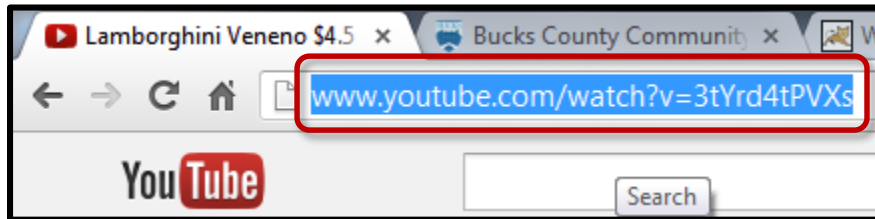


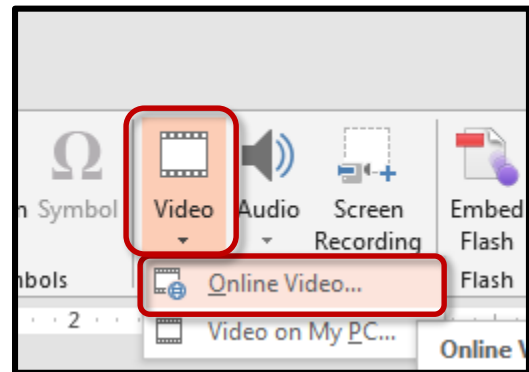
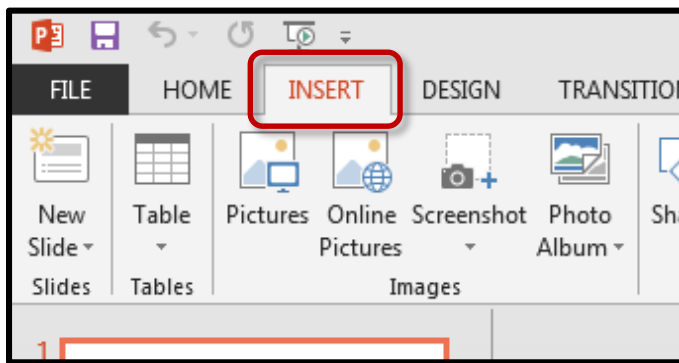
Inserting a YouTube video into a PowerPoint Presentation

Follow these steps to embed a YouTube video into a PowerPoint slide that will play when you run your presentation. This tutorial is using PowerPoint 2013.

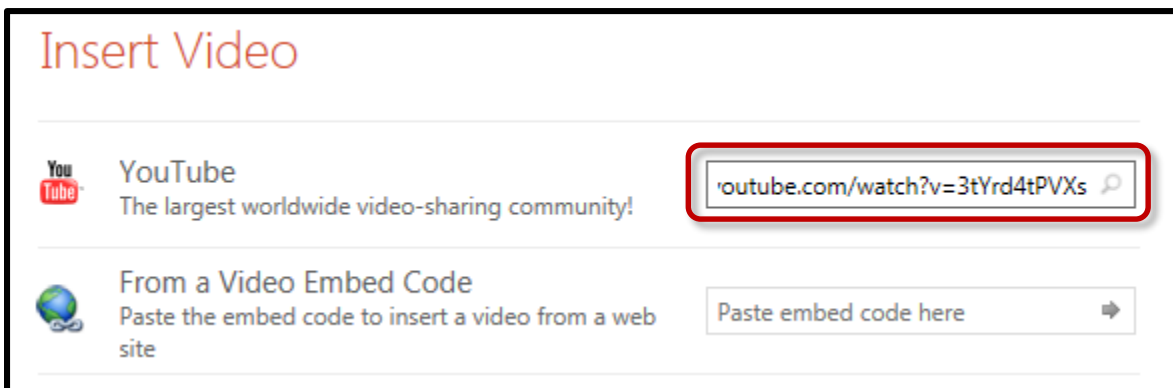
1. Open the YouTube video you wish to add to your PowerPoint slide. Copy the YouTube link from the address bar in your browser.



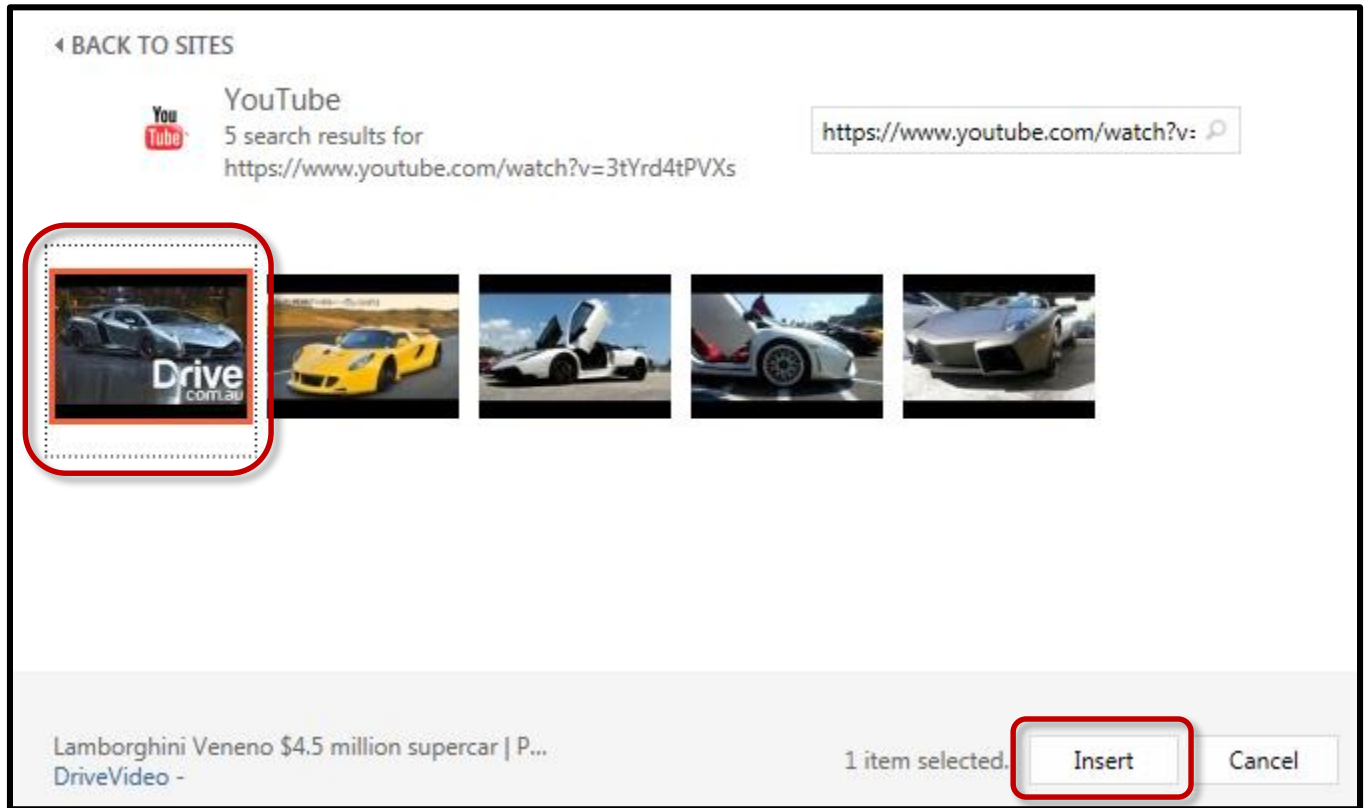
2. Open PowerPoint and click the **Insert** ribbon. Click **Video**, then **Online Video**.



3. Paste the YouTube link into the YouTube text box and press Enter or click the magnifying glass.



- Several video results may appear. The first thumbnail should be the video you found from YouTube. Click on it to select it (an orange border will appear) and click **Insert**.



- A placeholder for your video will appear on your slide. You can move it and resize it as needed. Drag from one of the four corners to resize the video proportionally. **Please note:** The video will not play until you enter the full screen slideshow.
