IMPORTANT NOTES

1. When selecting a Social Science elective for the Psychology program, students should choose from PSYC180, 181, 200, or 280.
2. If selecting a Literature elective, students should choose from LITR205, 206, 231, 232, 234, 235, 254, 255, 275, 277, 278, or 279. This, along with COMP111, will satisfy the Literature requirement at Gwynedd Mercy University.
3. Additional GMU requirements that can be completed at Bucks include two semesters of the same foreign language (required for BA degree).
4. Students may transfer 60 credits, but only up to 80 credits. Gwynedd Mercy University has a minimum 45 credit residency requirement and 50% of the major courses must be completed through Gwynedd Mercy University.
5. The minimum passing grade to transfer is C (a grade of C- is not acceptable). All transfer credits must be C or above.
