Advising for Gwynedd Mercy University BS CIS-Forensics option

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. When selecting a Science elective for Gwynedd Mercy University, choose Lab science PHYS or CHEM.
2. Additional CIS-Forensics major requirements that can be taken at Bucks include: CISF102 and CISF210.
3. Students may transfer 63 credits, but only up to 80 credits. Gwynedd Mercy University has a 45 credit residency requirement. At least 50% of the Computer Science-Forensics major requirements must be completed through Gwynedd Mercy University.
4. The minimum passing grade for transfer is C (a grade of C- is not acceptable).
