+ **12th Credit Level of Proficiency in a Single Foreign Language**-must complete Language 202.

++ At least 9 cr. Natural Science Required – **At Least one must be a Laboratory Science.**

At least 6 cr. Quantification Required – MATH 101,102, 110, 115, and higher are appropriate.

+++ Electives: Lang (see + above); HIST, LITR, HUMN, PHIL, VAFA, MUSIC 101

Coursework from other colleges and universities **must be evaluated separately.**

Remedial and Developmental coursework are **NOT** included in transferable credits.

Transfer courses **MUST** have a grade of “C” or better.
