## **Bachelor of Science in Nursing** 126 credits ACCEL® (on-campus or off-site location)

Transfer Criteria:

- 1. Students must complete the ACCEL® requirements at Immaculata
- 2. Students must have an RN certification for admission to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program
- 3. Students who transfer 54 or more credits will be classified as a Junior
- 4. Courses will be transferred only if completed with a grade of "C" or better
- 5. Courses transfer into the following areas:
  - a. Liberal Arts core
  - b. Additional requirements
  - c. Major requirements: ACCEL Program
  - d. 30 credits Lower Division Nursing
- 6. Students must earn a minimum of 60 credits at Immaculata University to be eligible for Latin Honors at graduation
