**Transfer Facts for Jefferson- East Falls Campus Undergraduate Day Classes**

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**General Information**

1. Is on-campus housing available for transfer students? **Yes**  
Cost? **Varies depending on building**
2. Full-time tuition for 18-19 school year: **\$39,495**  
Part-time tuition for 18-19 school year: **\$1,280 per credit**  
Is evening tuition different? **Yes**
3. Scholarship availability for transfer students: **Transfer scholarships are based on academics and range from \$6,000-\$13,000 per year. We also give a \$2,000 scholarship per year to members of the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society.**
4. Can a transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in two years? **It depends on the major and the courses the student took at Bucks. Design majors can take longer because of the sequencing of design classes.**
5. Can a transfer student complete baccalaureate programs on an evening schedule? **Yes, but it is through a different office- Continuing and Professional Studies.**

**Transfer Requirements**

1. Best time(s) to apply? Deadline(s)? **Deadline for the spring semester is December 1<sup>st</sup>. Deadline for the fall semester is June 1<sup>st</sup>. We review applications after the deadline on a space available basis.**
2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **Depends on students major**  
Prefer? **Minimum of 2.50 GPA.**

3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **Varies depending on major.**
4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **We accept the college GPA.**
5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **60.**
6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Usually within 2 weeks after acceptance.**
7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **Only if the student has less than 30 college credits or they did not take a college math.**
8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **Yes, for students that enroll at Jefferson, we require the final high school transcript or GED. We also require it during the application process if a student has less than 30 college credits or did not take a college math.**
9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **No.**
10. Are D's transferable? With an AA degree? Without an AA degree? **No, we accept grades of C or higher.**
11. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? **We accept AP/IB credits but we do not accept CLEP credits.**

### **Programs**

1. Which programs, if any, are closed to transfer students? **We do not accept transfers into our combined bachelor to masters OT and PA programs. Students interested in OT and PA can complete a bachelors in Health Science and then apply separately to the masters program.**
2. Popular majors: **Architecture, Fashion Design, Interior Design, Industrial Design, Graphic Design, Heath Science, Pre-Med**
3. New or distinctive majors: Combined **bachelor to master's degree in Athletic Training, Combined bachelor to Master's degree in Community and Trauma Counseling, Engineering**
