

Connecting to Wi-Fi for Students

Wireless connectivity is available in multiple places on campus. Following are the directions on how to connect to the Wi-Fi on campus using the BucksNet Connections.

To create NEW BucksNet Connections – for student’s personal laptops

This is an unsecure wireless network with Internet Access Only

- Click once on the “white” wireless signal – using the left mouse button
 - Choose
 - Use Windows to manage Wi-Fi
 - Dialog Box will appear
 - “Do you want Windows to manage your wireless (Wi-Fi) network connections?”
 - Click – YES
- Right Click on the Wireless Computer symbol
 - Choose - View available wireless networks
 - Choose the BucksNet
 - Click – Connect
- Double click Internet Explorer (IE) – the Blue “E”
 - Note: IE must be used for the scanning feature
 - Student’s machines will be scanned once a day
- The following dialog boxes may/will appear.
 - Security Alerts
 - “You are about to view pages over a secure connection.”
 - Click – OK
 - Security Certificates
 - Click – YES (to proceed)
- The page will automatically redirect to the BlueSocket – Login Screen, which contains the “Access Agreement”
- Login using your “email” username and password
 - Save Password – Dialog Box
 - ***Not a good practice in this incidence of wireless connectivity***
- Another dialog box may/will appear
 - Internet Explorer – Security Warning
 - Installer for **Integrity Security Scanner**

- Click Install
 - NOTE: - this is required for on campus connectivity
 - *Student's machines will be scanned once a day*
 - Integrity Scanner
 - Click – YES
- After scanning, automatic redirection will go to Internet Explorer's designated home page.
