GENERAL INFORMATION

Best time to apply: **Rolling (see website for priority deadlines). Spaces in some programs (specifically fine arts and education) are limited. Applying 4-6 months prior to the desired semester of enrollment is recommended.**

1. Will you evaluate a transcript prior to receiving a formal application? **Yes, transcripts can be faxed (along with the credit evaluation request form printed from our website) for evaluation to 215-572-4049. Transfer Evaluation Days are also held monthly—call for upcoming dates.**
2. Is housing available for transfer students? **Yes, on campus housing is guaranteed for all full-time students who deposit by the housing deadline (May 1 for fall.)**

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

1. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.5** Prefer: **GPA depends on the number and rigor of academic courses completed by the student.**
2. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **Physician Assistant Studies – 3.2; Physical Therapy – 3.2; Education –3.0 to qualify for student teaching.**
3. When you are evaluating an applicant, will you accept the GPA as computed by the two-year college? **Yes**
4. Maximum number of credits accepted from a two-year institution: **75**
5. When does the applicant learn which credits will transfer? **A preliminary credit evaluation can be completed at the student's request. If the student has not requested one prior to acceptance, an evaluation will be mailed with the acceptance letter.**
6. Who evaluates the course for transfer credit? **The Office of Enrollment Management completes preliminary evaluations. Final review is done by the registrar and/or the department advisor.**
7. Can the transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in two years? **Usually, although it depends on the major and the courses taken in the associate degree program.**
8. Are SAT or ACT scores required for admission? **No**
9. Should a student with an associate degree submit the high school transcript or GED? **No**
10. With fewer than 30 credits? **Yes**
11. Is the transfer student required to have completed the same high school courses as an entering freshman? (foreign language, math) **No specific high school coursework is required.**
