

REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF CATALOG YEAR

When applying to Bucks County Community College, or when changing your program of study (major), you are automatically assigned to the degree requirements in the college catalog that is in effect on that date. If changes are made to the degree requirements for your program of study, the College follows the principle that you should not be required to take additional courses or credits or be hindered toward the completion of the program of study you have been assigned.

However, you may choose to follow the newer degree requirements for your program of study by changing your catalog year to the current year.

It is strongly suggested that you discuss this change with an academic advisor or member of the Registrar's Office before you submit this form.
