The National Healthcareer Association offers the certification test to become a Certified EKG Technician (CET). This certification exam is not required for students completing the non-credit program EKG Technician; however, upon successful completion of the courses in this program, students are eligible to take a national certification exam for EKG Technician.

The CET certification test includes:

- EKG Monitoring (60% of the exam)
- Patient Care (40% of the exam)

Students at Bucks County Community College typically sit for one certification test through the National Healthcareer Association. The certification test includes the EKG (CET).

From 5/28/2019 to 12/16/2019, a total of 25 distinct learners have attempted to take at least 1 NHA certification.

These learners have attempted a total of 25 exams, ultimately resulting in 18 certifications being rewarded.

The average pass rate over this period is 72%, which is equal to the national average pass rate of all NHA testers (72%).

16% of learners have used digital certification prep materials prior to their first exam attempt.
