The National Healthcareer Association offers the certification test to become a Certified EKG Technician (CET). This certification exam is not required for students completing the non-credit program EKG/Phlebotomy Technician; however, upon successful completion of the courses in this program, students are eligible to take two separate national certification exams for EKG and Phlebotomy Technician.

The CET certification test includes:

- EKG Monitoring (60% of the exam)
- Patient Care (40% of the exam)

Students at Bucks County Community College typically sit for the EKG test as one of three certification tests through the National Healthcareer Association. These certification test statistics only include the EKG (CET) test. During 2018 (5/22/18 – 12/4/18), 20 unique Bucks County Community College students sat for the EKG test, ultimately resulting in 20 certifications being awarded.

The average pass rate over this period is 100%, which is 12 percentage points above the national average pass rate of all NHA testers (88%).
