

## Connecting to the BUCKS wireless network

BUCKS is the new wireless network for students, faculty, and staff. Follow these directions to connect your Android tablet or phone to the new wireless network. Your steps may vary depending on the model of your Android device.

1. On your home screen or app drawer, go into your **Settings** and browse to your wireless settings.
2. Find the **BUCKS** network and tap on it to connect.

There are several pieces of information you will need to enter to connect to the BUCKS network:

- **EAP method:** PEAP (It should default to this option)
  - **Phase 2 authentication:** Leave this blank
  - **CA certificate:** Use system certificates
    - **Note:** If you do not have the option for “Use system certificates” instead choose Do not validate
  - **Domain:** bucks.edu
    - **Note:** The domain is only required if you have selected “Use system certificates”
  - **Identity:** Enter your Bucks username.
  - **Anonymous identity:** Enter your Bucks username again.
  - **Password:** Type in your password (used to access campus computers, MyBucks, Canvas)
3. Tap **Connect** when the information above has been entered.
