Determination

Based upon its review of the Contractor Responsibility Certification, Subcontractor Responsibility Certifications, Subcontractor List, and all supporting documentation submitted



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by QPI Electrical Co., Inc, and any additional inquiries conducted by BCCC, the College has determined that QPI Electrical Co., Inc **meets the requirements of the BCCC Responsible Contractor Policy** and is hereby deemed a qualified, responsible contractor for the above-referenced project.

Specifically, BCCC has verified the following:

1. Valid licenses, registrations, and credentials are in good standing.
2. Bonding and insurance requirements are satisfied.
3. No debarments, suspensions, defaults, or license revocations within the past three years.
4. No disqualifying criminal convictions within the past ten years.
5. No qualifying law violations resulting in fines or penalties of \$5,000 or more within the past three years.
6. OSHA 10-hour training compliance confirmed for all craft labor; OSHA 30-hour compliance confirmed for designated site supervisor.
7. Participation in a Class A Apprenticeship Program verified for all applicable trades.
8. Minimum 70% journey person/registered apprentice workforce requirement acknowledged.
9. Prevailing wage compliance (43 Pa. Cons. Stat. § 165-1 et seq.) confirmed.
10. Subcontractor Responsibility Certifications reviewed and approved for all listed subcontractors.
11. Sufficient technical, financial, and personnel resources verified to successfully perform the contract.

Conditions and Next Steps

This Determination is subject to the following conditions:

12. **Board of Trustees Approval and Final Contract Execution.** Pursuant to §10(a) of Policy 6.12, a final contract shall not be executed until (a) formal approval has been obtained from the BCCC Board of Trustees, (b) this Contractor Responsibility Determination is in effect, and (c) all other requirements of the Policy have been fulfilled. Upon satisfaction of all conditions, BCCC may execute a final contract based upon the Notice of Intent to Award.



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13. **Public Posting.** BCCC will publicly post this Determination, the Notice of Intent to Award, Responsibility Certifications, and the Subcontractor List on the BCCC website for five (5) calendar days prior to contract execution, pursuant to §10(b) of Policy 6.12.
14. **Ongoing Compliance.** This Determination may be revoked at any time if BCCC obtains information indicating the firm is no longer a responsible contractor. Pursuant to §3(c)(15) of the Policy, QPI Electrical Co., Inc must notify BCCC within Ten (10) days of any material changes to the matters attested to in its Contractor Responsibility Certification.
15. **Subcontractor Changes.** No substitution of listed subcontractors is permitted without prior written authorization from BCCC and submission of a completed Subcontractor Responsibility Certification for any substitute firm.
16. **False Certifications.** BCCC reserves all rights under §9 of the Policy with respect to false or misleading certifications, including disqualification, payment withholding, contract termination, and a three-year prohibition on performing work for BCCC.
