- 5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: There is no maximum, although students must meet University Requirements to secure an ESU degree. - 6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? Students offered admission will receive their Transfer Credit Evaluation (TCE) with their offer of admission.
- 7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? No.
- 8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? No.

Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? Yes, only as proof of high school graduation.

With less than 30 credits? Yes. We will use the high school record and college GPA for application with less than 12 attempted college credits at the time of application.

9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? Only if transferring with less than 12 college-level credits attempted at the time of application. Admission for applicants with 12 or > college credits at the time of application will be based on college-level grades.

If yes, can these be satisfied by college courses? Yes

Will these courses also be credited toward the baccalaureate? Yes, if the equivalent course is complete at the community college with a passing C grade or better.

- 10. Are D's transferable? Yes, if the student transfers with a conferred A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 11. With an AA degree? Yes. Same as stated above.

Without an AA degree? No. Explain. College level credits with a grade of "C" of better are considered for transfer credit. C-or D grades will only be considered if the Bucks CCC transfers under the Pennsylvania Transfer Policy or through a program-to-program agreement indicating a C- or D will transfer.

12. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? Yes, we accept AP, CLEP, JTS although the course will not be taken from the Bucks CCC transcript. The applicant must send official score reports directly from College Board or Military Service to the ESU Office of Admissions.

- 13. Which programs, if any, are closed to transfer students? **No programs are closed to transfer students, although Nursing has very limited seat availability.**
