Non-traditional students* who are interested in online or hybrid offerings through the DSU ACCESS Program should apply *at least* one session (8 weeks) prior to their intended start date.
- Graduate from Bucks with an A.A. or A.S. degree, with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for courses required in and offered by the major at DSU.
- Satisfy all other DSU transfer and admission requirements.
