A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission.

Transfer students are required to participate in a weekend retreat (Friday 3 PM to Sunday 3 PM) early in their first semester at USciences.

Graduation from USciences with a BS degree requires completion of specified courses and a total of 121-136 credit hours, depending upon the degree program. In order to enter USciences with U3 (junior) status and to facilitate the completion of a BS degree in two years of study at USciences, all students are strongly advised to complete more than 60 total credits of course work which is eligible for transfer to USciences. Students interested in transferring to USciences are strongly urged to contact the USciences Admission Office early in their enrollment at Bucks for advising.

In addition to the coursework provided in the above table, the following types of courses will be needed to complete the *General Education Discipline Requirements* in USciences' General Education Curriculum:

- 3 credits in Humanities

These 3 credits of coursework will be completed after transferring to USciences (currently included in the 3rd year at USciences) by taking ET313 Business Ethics
