# The following Mathematics courses may be selected at BCCC Any one of the courses will also fulfill the Core: Mathematics requirement at Holy Family University.

MATH 117: Finite Mathematics for Business (3) (Core: Quantification)

As of Fall 2013 course re-evaluation at Holy Family University.

MATH 120: College Algebra (4) (Core: Quantification)

MATH 122: Trigonometry/Analytic Geometry (3) (MATH 150=)

MATH 125: Pre-calculus Mathematics (4) (MATH 150=)

MATH 140: Calculus I (4) (MATH 211=)

*The BCCC student may also select MATH 101: Mathematical Concepts I (3) (MATH 122=) or MATH 115: Statistics (3) (MATH 130=) to fulfill the Math requirement at Bucks County Community College; however, **neither** of these courses will fulfill the Core: Mathematics requirement at Holy Family University and another Math course which will fulfill the Core requirement will be required at Holy Family University.*

(##) The course (HIST 113 or HIST 114) not chosen under the required History choice of HIST 113 (HIST 108) or HIST 114 (HIST 208) should be taken to fulfill the General Elective course in the Liberal Arts: History curriculum at BCCC, to fulfill a Major requirement in the History degree at Holy Family University.

@ **NOTE:** As a History major the student will need to replace the core history courses required, since these courses are required in the major and therefore cannot be used to fulfill a core requirement. The BCCC student should take both PSYC 110(PSYC 101) and SOCI 110(SOCO 101) at BCCC.

One course will fulfill the Core: Social Consciousness #2 requirement; the other will fulfill the required Core replacement course for Global Perspective #3 requirement for HISTORY majors.

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**Additional information regarding HISTORY concentration:**

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required.

A minimum of 60 credits must be earned at Holy Family University to be eligible for commencement honors.

Note: Course sequence progression is based on admission to Holy Family University for the Fall semester; however, admission is possible in both the Fall and Spring semesters in this program of study since course offerings permit sequence adjustment.
