3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **Sciences and Education require closer to 3.0**
4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **GPA as calculated by previous College**
5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **78 approx.; student must complete 48 DVC credits**
6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **Evaluation completed within 2 weeks of acceptance**
7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **No**
8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **Yes**
